Joe did a great job staying clean and stringing strikes together on this tough oil condition, and Randy performed great in his first ever M.I.S.T. finals, but it just wasn't enough to get by a red hot Joe Colcord. Randy did a great job, though, picking up a 4th place finish, netting \$170 and picking up 150 BOY points. Nice bowling Randy and congrats on your first M.I.S.T. finals appearance, I'm sure it won't be your last! Our next match would feature our defending Bowler of the Year, Joe Ramsdell III, squaring off against the man for whom he ripped that Bowler of the Year title away from, Joe Colcord. Here is the result of their heavy weight match:

Joe Ramsdell III showed mental toughness, and a very good ball reaction, in pulling away to a victory in the semi-final match against Joe Colcord. It was higher scoring once again and full of excitement. Joe Colcord can't hang his head though, as he did a great job this month, winning his first match, and ending with a 3rd place finish. Joe Colcord made \$210, and picked up 200 BOY points on the day. Nice bowling Joe. Our final match would feature a first time M.I.S.T. finalist and top seed Aaron Thiboutot, taking on finals veteran Joe Ramsdell III. Aaron moved from 5th all the way to the #1 seed in the position round game, a feat never accomplished in the M.I.S.T. before. That was some very impressive bowling by Aaron. Let's see who would come away with the M.I.S.T. title this month, the veteran or the new comer:

Joe showed why he is the reigning Bowler of the Year, throwing great shots when he needed them, and minimizing his mistakes. Aaron struggled in the final match, but he has nothing to be ashamed of, as he bowled fantastic all day long, and will surely be back in the finals again very soon. Aaron did a stellar job all day, picking up a 2nd place finish, \$280, and 250 BOY points. The story today, though, was Joe Ramsdell III, who was able to control his ball reaction on this tough oil pattern, keep his emotions in check, and pick up yet another M.I.S.T. title. Joe earned \$365 for the victory and took home 300 BOY points. Great bowling Joe and he puts himself in a great position in this years Bowler of the Year points race.
