M.I.S.T. #6, 2013 – 2014 SEASON: YANKEE LANES, BRUNSWICK, ME.

This is the recap for the Maine Invitational Scratch Tournament held on February 9, 2014 at Yankee Lanes in Brunswick, ME. This was the 6th tournament out of our 7 tournament season. I would like to thank Nelson Moody, Jake Jacobs, and all the staff at Yankee Lanes for once again allowing us to host a M.I.S.T. tournament at their fine bowling center. We used a unique oil pattern for this tournament, as we do every year here, and that was to have a long oil pattern on every left lane, and a short oil pattern on every right lane. This year we used Team USA Mexico City on the left lane, which was 45ft. in length, and on all the right lanes we used Team USA Los Angeles, which was 36ft. in length. This format keeps bowlers on their toes, and really forces you to concentrate on targeting and ball speed on every shot. I would like to thank Brunswick Bowling for donating the Brunswick Mastermind high end bowling ball, which was won by Aaron Thiboutot. Thank you to John Bovoy and BowlPro Sales for donating a bottle of Knockout premium bowling ball cleaner, which was won this month by Josh Greenlaw. Congrats to both of our winners this month. Also, thank you to Scott Moore of Moore's Pro Shop for sponsoring our Bowler of the Year competition.
