## Junior Gold Rules for Maine State Youth Open

- 1. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and shall be governed by USBC and Maine State Youth Open rules.
- 2. The tournament will be held at Family Fun Bowling Center in Bangor, ME, the weekends of April 11/12, 2015 and April 18/19, 2015.
- 3. The Champions of the MSUSBC Youth Open (Scratch Boy and Girl All Events Winners) will receive a qualifying spot at the Junior Gold Championships in Dupage County, IL, in July 2015. There are no alternates for the qualifying spots. The bowler must have a Junior Gold membership before participating in the tournament, in order to receive a qualifying spot. Membership fee is \$30.
- 4. The entry fee for All Events is \$45 (\$3 All Event fee, and \$14 for each event-Singles, Doubles, Team). There is no extra charge for the Junior Gold qualifier.
- 5. In the event of a tie for Scratch All Events, the bowler with the **highest series** in an event will receive the qualifying spot.
- 6. The All Events winners will receive scholarships based on a 1:20 ratio, which will be reported by the MSUSBC Youth Open tournament director, Bonnie Harzewski. There will be no extra money prize for Junior Gold qualifying.
- 7. A minimum of 4 Junior Gold members will be required to be considered a Junior Gold qualifier.
